

Sebby's Corner Charity. No child should go without.

Sebby's corner is a charity based in Barnet supporting vulnerable families and children under the age of 10 living in poverty across London and the Southeast including Potters Bar and the surrounding area. It is now five years since the charity was started.

Sebby's Corner provide essential resources such as nappies, baby formula, baby equipment, clothing, school uniforms and birthday gifts to families in need.

Sebby's Corner believes that no child should go without the essentials that they need to thrive

Many of the families they help are experiencing homelessness, fleeing domestic violence, seeking asylum or living in poverty.

Referrals are made by frontline professionals including social workers, midwives, health visitors and family support workers to ensure that they are reaching the most vulnerable families. There are over 1000 referral partners

By meeting immediate material needs they can help stabilise families and reduce stress and improve the well-being of both parents and children

Sebby's corner believe it is impossible to break free from debt, apply for work or rebuild your life when you don't know where your babies next nappy is coming from and that's where their support begins

I worked as a Health Visitor for over thirty years. During that time I saw what a difference practical support made to children and families. I am now volunteering at the hub in Barnet and organising a quiz and silent auction on Saturday thirteenth of June at Our Lady and St Vincent Church, Mutton Lane, Potters Bar. These are some of the amazing things that Sebby's corner does

Hospital bags for a vulnerable mother to be

You can sponsor all or part of a pack

This includes essential items for a baby approximate cost £4

Essentials for labour approximate cost about £8p

Toiletries for mum approximately £10

Postpartum essentials care package approximately £18 or a complete hospital bag packed with all the essentials for £40

Birthday club.

Each child is provided with a gift, balloons and a cake because every child deserves a celebration

School uniform support

This provides new uniform and shoes, backpack, lunch box and stationary to help children return to school with dignity and confidence for children from reception to year six.

Christmas support

A festive shop is offered where struggling parents can choose gifts for their children using a point system. This helps families in hardship celebrate with dignity and joy.

Essential items

Individual new unopened items such such as toiletries for young children and teenagers including toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, body wash are much appreciated for hygiene packs

Packs of new nappies, nappy cream, infant paracetamol and ibuprofen, feeding bottles, baby bath, baby shampoo, breast pads, sanitary towels can be added to the hospital bag pack or used for the essential items packs

Birthday club
